# Family Registration Center Student Information Management

## Gateway Registration:

- **New Student Registration Gateway**, open for parents/guardians year-round, is used to register new students to New Bedford Public Schools, grades K-12. For preschool-aged students, it is used for placement on a wait list which is regularly monitored and updated by the Early Childhood Office.
- **Back to School Gateway**, open for parents/guardians to complete during a predetermined time period at the beginning of the school year, asks parents/guardians to update and confirm contact information, demographics, participation in parent councils, and interest in sports and afterschool activities.
- **Express Gateway**, open for parents/guardians year-round, gives them the ability to update addresses and contact information.

These tools will enable New Bedford Public Schools to expand and archive its electronic data collection. Online format permits families to provide information regarding permissions, releases, and verify mode of transportation to and from school.

The FRC is prepared to support families with the online registration process if needed.

# Technology Services

- **Staff Devices**
  - Laptops for all staff are being checked for any needed repairs, reimaged, and returned to staff. These will be completed before the start of the school year.
  - New laptops will be provided to any new staff and will be provided to staff with outdated devices.
- **Student Devices**
  - Current inventory of devices is being audited by Tech Services now. First pass of audits are complete.
  - New devices will be provided to meet all school needs for start of next school year.
- **System Preparations**
  - Now that the summer learning programs have ended and our end of SY20-21 state reporting has been completed, we are preparing our student information system, Aspen, for rollover to initialize the SY21-22 and finalize student and staff schedules and rosters.
  - Once schedules and rosters have been completed, we will begin loading our data into all of our 3rd party educational software modules, i.e. Clever, Renaissance Learning, Pearson-SAVVAS, Lexia, etc.
- **Help Desk and Tech Support**
  - Tech Services will keep the help desk running next school year – support line # is 508-997-4518
  - New Support Ticket System is being deployed. One-to-One Plus. Training sessions for schools are currently ongoing.
  - Device tracking/inventory - One-to-One Plus is also being setup to service as our device tracking system for tech equipment distributed to students and staff. Training sessions for schools are currently ongoing.
- **Hotspots**
  - We are prepared to provide hotspots to students for remote learning that are in need of home internet access. We are applying for federal funding to cover the cost of unlimited data plans on the hotspots.

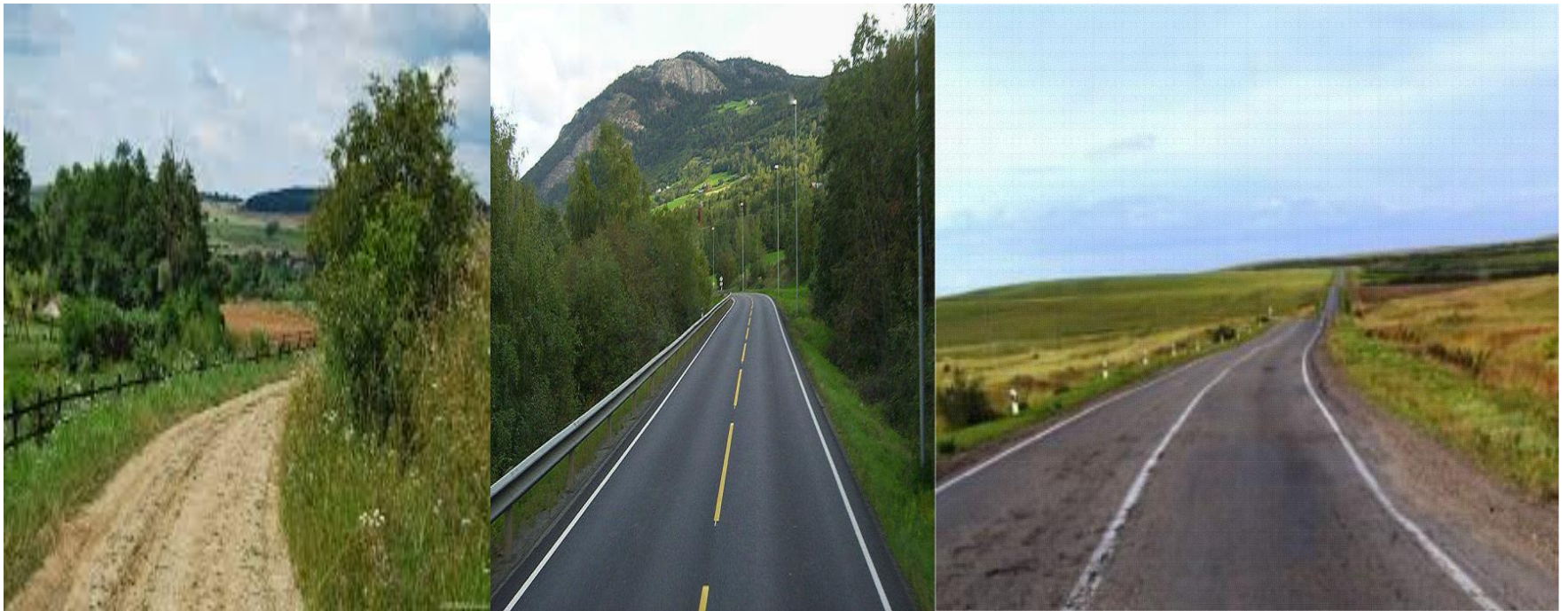

Our decision making continues to be grounded in reviewing local, regional, and national trends on this pandemic as it affects our planning. As we know, there are numerous areas which we are still working to resolve based on the best available research, guidance, and practices. These areas include, but are not limited to, the following:

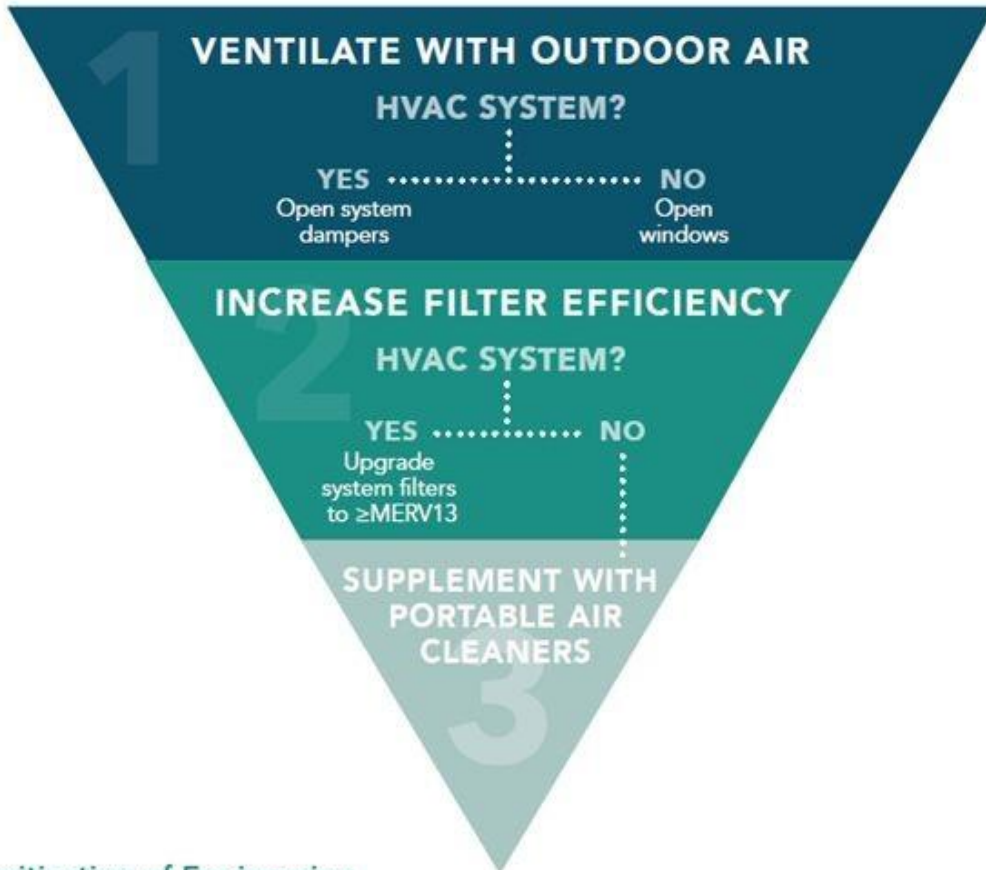
- **Continuity of Learning:** Plans are ready to be implemented on how to best balance continuity of learning with the protocols in place
  - School plans to accommodate teacher absences due to quarantine and isolation are being developed
- **Staffing:** Staff availability may be affected and unpredictable due to several factors including staff health, staff virus exposure requiring quarantine or isolation, and childcare access



## Focus on School Readiness

- Safety and well-being of students, staff, and families remain our top priority and facility management and maintenance is guided by risk mitigation and health and safety promotion
- NBPS is preparing facilities and adapting operating procedures to adhere to medically-advised health and safety requirements

# STEPS TAKEN TO MAINTAIN VENTILATION AND AIR EXCHANGE



1. Ventilate Air

2. Increase Filter Efficiency

3. Supplement with Portable Air Cleaners

Prioritization of Engineering Controls to Reduce Long-Range Airborne Transmission

## Continue Ventilation and Air Exchange

- **Adjust HVAC settings:** Adjust settings to increase the flow of outdoor air
- **Open windows or doors (when appropriate and safe):** For facilities without the above HVAC capability, evaluate the options to open windows and doors when safe to do so, as well as the feasibility of increasing outdoor air intake with fan boxes in windows
- **Prevent or minimize air recirculation:** Facilities staff will evaluate how to eliminate or minimize air recirculation in their HVAC systems to the extent possible
- Measure carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) as a proxy for ventilation
